Good afternoon,

First of all I would like to welcome Sway to Redcotts for which I hope to be a good game of football. It feels strange playing a home game after 4 consecutive games on the road.

Where do I start? Our last home game was against Portcastrian, a side that is high in the table and well respected. Again we came out dominating the game leading 3-1 with 10 mins to go. It was surely a certain 3 points! But we threw it away to draw the game 3-3. Another lapse in concentration.

Our next game away to Parley couldn't have started better 3-0 up after 8 minutes showing discipline in keeping our shape to only throw away 3 cheap goals. We went in at half time leading 4-3. The second half was a very good half defensively. The Parley bench and players were getting very frustrated and animated. This led to both sides ending the game with 10 men. I must admit it was probably the best ref of the season. Game finished 4-3.

Our next game away at Wareham, a side sat top unbeaten in Dorset senior full of confidence. Again we played very good football going forward dominating the game. Still had these lapses in concentration at the back but were saved by some brilliance of Gary Smart at times. A world class save was unfortunately turned in. I need to emphasise how well we have been doing to pull out results only losing 1 of our last 7 games with basically a different team each week. We need to get some stability in availability in order to progress further and this is something I will be looking to install in the First Team.

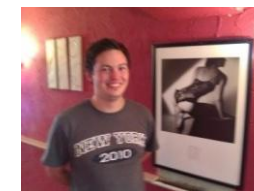


