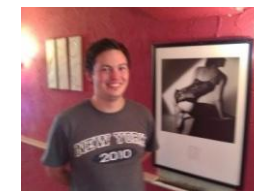

Allendale Reserves Vs Boldre

Following the disappointment of our previous game, the extra time cup defeat to Bransgore the squad was back at full strength and were very much up for it after the festive period.

We arrived to the farmer's field of Boldre and in the warm up we were fully aware that composure needed to be there from the start with the surface uneven and some stronger results from Boldre of recent. We started well and piled on pressure from the start, this paying dividends (unlike UK banks) on around 10 minutes when a ball from myself over the top of the opposition defence to Stuart Pomeroy who clinically buried the ball to give us the lead. We very much dominated the first half and eventually made it 2-0 with the second goal coming from a great passing move from the defence via midfield to Bradley Fitzwalter to slot away.

A strong display at the back as a unit must also be mentioned, especially Dan Anson having to defend our left hand side particularly in the first half with their keeper distributing long balls to their right winger every time.

A fantastic team performance and one that we need to continue with against FC Bournemouth at Slades Farm.
